Consider using similes and sensory details. Avoid using words such as, "just", "really", "sort of", "nice", "bad", "kind of", "I think", "I believe", "I feel" and "honestly". Must be at least 5-7 sentences long.

As a character from this book, write a postcard to another character from the book. Make sure to have an image on the front, and a clearly written note, so we know who the note is from and who the note is to. The note should be 5-7 sentences long.

Rewrite a scene and change the gender of the characters to show how they might act differently. The scene should include dialogue, and inner thinking of the character. Required length is 2 paragraphs..

Translate each chapter into a cartoon. Draw the most important scene in each chapter, explaining its importance and action.

Keep a diary as if you were a character in the story. Write down events that happen during the story and reflect on how they affected the character and why. There should be 5 entries with 5-7 sentences each.

Create a 5 minute podcast explaining why the characters are the way they are and share

How do you connect to the author's story? If you wrote your own story, how would it be different or the same as the author's? In a 2 paragraph explanation, answer the prompt and remember to use compare and contrast key words to help the flow of your work.

Write an interview or letter in which the character in the book asks the author a series of 15 questions and answers that reflect on how they feel about the way they were made.
